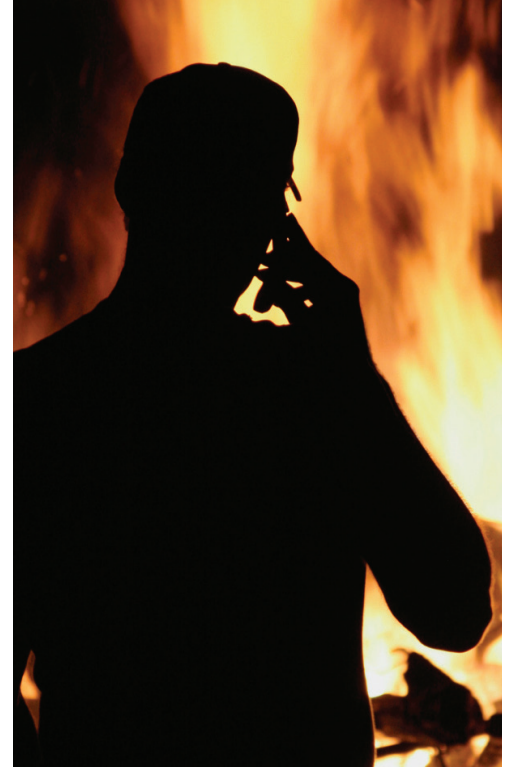


American Recovery and Reinvestment Act – Public Safety, Firefighter, Justice, Corrections, Homeland Security Opportunities

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) provides more than \$4B for state and local law enforcement and other criminal and juvenile justice activities with the Office of Justice Programs (OJP) administering nearly three-quarters (\$2.76B) of total dollars available. Grants for construction and modification of fire stations offered through the Department of Homeland Security are available also.



Qualifying programs include:

- \$2B [Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant \(JAG\) Program](#) – to help prevent, fight, and prosecute crime.
- \$1B Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) grants – supporting the hiring of additional law enforcement officers. ARRA waives the 25% local match requirement and the \$75K salary cap per officer.
- \$225M [Edward Byrne Competitive Grant Program](#) – to prevent crime by improving the administration of justice and to provide services to victims of crime, and other activities.
- \$225M [Violence Against Women grants](#) – \$175M of total funds is for formula grants and the remaining \$50M is to be used for transitional housing assistance.
- \$100M [Grants for Victims Compensation and Assistance](#) – supporting state compensation and assistance programs for victims and survivors of crime.
- \$125M [Assistance to Rural Law Enforcement to Combat Crime and Drugs](#) – in grants to combat drug-related crime in rural areas.
- \$40M [Southwest border/Project Gunrunner](#) – in competitive grants to provide assistance and equipment to local law enforcement along the border with Mexico and in high-intensity drug trafficking areas to combat narcotics activity. \$10M of these funds is to be transferred to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives for “Project Gunrunner”.
- \$225M [Assistance for Tribal Law Enforcement](#) – to be distributed to American Indian and Alaska Native tribes for construction of jails on tribal lands.
- \$50M [Grants for Internet Crimes Against Children Initiatives](#) to enhance investigative responses to predators using the Internet or other technology to exploit children sexually.
- \$210M [Assistance to Firefighters Grants Recovery Plan](#) to fund construction and modification of fire stations. Grants will be awarded to a variety of fire departments including: paid, volunteer and combination fire departments; fire departments located

in communities of varying sizes; and fire departments located in urban, suburban and rural communities.
